**About Us:**

**West Coast Kids Cancer Foundation (WCK)** exists to deliver timely, practical support to respond to the needs of BC kids and their families, easing their way as they navigate childhood cancer and blood disorders. We are a new, vibrant and motivated organization looking to challenge the status quo of support for kids with cancer in BC.

**About you:**

You feel confident and comfortable supporting complex behavioural needs. You are a creative solution finder and can quickly adapt to support the needs of children. Under your behavioural support 'super cape,' you are a master of building trust and rapport with children with all types of needs.

**In a nutshell:**

WCK is planning three weeks of City Camp for July 2023. We need exceptional behavioural support staff to provide a fun and safely supervised day camp experience for kids with cancer/blood disorders and their siblings. The behaviour support team works closely with WCK staff and volunteers to create an environment of fun where kids can make new friends, play outside and learn new skills.

**As a valued team member, the City Camp behavioural support team will:**

- Offer a warm, caring, patient presence to City Camp participants needing extra assistance.
- Assist program staff with group management, equipment setup, and transition between program activities.
- Support children and families with the transition of entering and exiting the program each day.
- Design and implement child-led program goals that promote their success in the day camp setting.
- Offer adapted and alternative activities for City Camp participants as needed.
- Assist children in meeting daily program expectations such as hand washing, wearing a mask, applying sunscreen etc.
- Model and teach friendship skills to help City Camp participants make peer connections.
- Help children individually or in small groups find success with activities and games.
- Report participant progress, successes and concerns to the WCK Staff team and parents.
- Support appropriate programming based on the physical, mental, and emotional needs of children and youth at camp.
- Maintain a safe environment via safety inspections, emergency procedures, and crisis intervention techniques.

**Qualifications and experience:**

- Post-secondary education in a related field, e.g. behavioural interventionist, educational assistant, educational resources assistant, special education assistant, childhood education, recreation therapy
- Experience working with children with exceptional and complex behaviour support needs is essential
- Solid communication skills and the ability to interact with individuals at all levels.
- Valid First Aid/CPR certificate.
- Secondary language skills are an asset.
- A clear Vulnerable Sector Criminal Records Check.
- Crisis prevention training is an asset.
